Precautions

Do not expose the LCD monitor directly under sunlight or other heat sources. When in use, the LCD screen should be facing away from light sources to reduce glare.

To clean the LCD panel:



Quick Installation


- 1. Make sure the computer and the LCD monitor are both turned off.

- 5. Plug one end of the video cable in the (Analog or Digital) video signal connector of LCD monitor and the other end in video signal connector of the computer.
- 6. Turn on the computer.
- 7. Turn on the LCD monitor.
- 8. Adjust the user controls to optimize your personal preference (see Operation section, call your local dealer if you have any problems).



OPERATIONS







Diagram 1 — Illustrates the display can tilt forward or backwards.


Diagram 2 — Illustrates the display can rotate left or right.








